I take solace in the success our teachers and students have already shown in their first weeks of digital learning. OLL will continue to offer digital learning to all students in Kindergarten through eighth grade.

OLL plans to work with all area high schools to ensure the proper completion of eighth grade for all of our graduating students. The eighth grade teachers and administration have been meeting online to discuss ideas regarding graduation prior to this closure. We will be in contact with eighth grade families as June draws near and as decisions are reached.

Monday, April 13th is Easter Monday, and there will be no digital instruction on that day. As a reminder, OLL has three upcoming professional development days on April 24, 27, and 28. These days will be used by teachers to plan and develop instruction for the remainder of the school year. There will be no digital instruction on these days.
