The OLL Administration continues to make plans for a healthy return to school in the fall. Although we have yet to receive direction from the state of Oregon regarding the amount of students that will be allowed in the building at any given time, we are nevertheless making plans for significant changes in our building and protocols to protect the health of our community members.

The Parish and School have purchased a UV magnetic sanitation/purification system for our HVAC system to be installed this summer. This technology kills bacteria, viruses, and mold. Additionally, OLL has committed additional funding to our custodial budget to sanitize. We will also be doing frequent deep cleans of the school and church, and we have plans to install more handwashing stations throughout the school. Regardless of what schedule the students and staff experience in the fall, planned handwashing breaks that ensure social distancing and safety will be a part of the students' schedule. As more decisions are reached, I will continue to share information with the OLL community.
